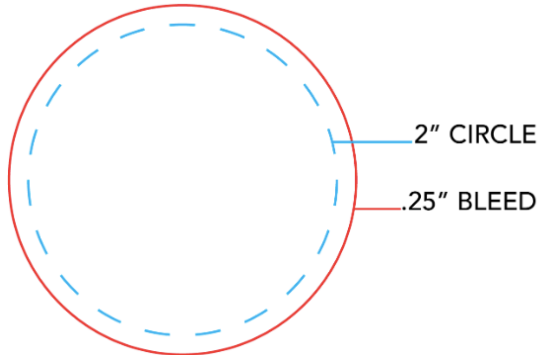


### *Rules and Criteria:*

#### **Criteria for Sticker Submission:**

- Must be a 2" circle with a ¼" bleed.
  - Must include one of the following: "I voted," "I voted today," "Future Voter", or Spanish equivalent
  - Words and artwork must be visible from a distance.
  - All submitted work must be the original work of the entrant(s) and must not include, be based on, or derived from any pre-existing or third-party designs, trademarks, or copyrighted images.
  - Must be nonpartisan
- \*\*Note: Winning submissions will be subject to language translations\*\***



#### **Dates to Keep in Mind:**

December 17th - January 31st (midnight EST): Submission window is open to the public

February 17th (10:00 am EST): Finalists in each category will be announced on the City Commissioners website and Public Voting begins.

February 17th-February 28th (5:00pm EST): The public may vote on their favorite semi-finalist in each category. Voters can vote once in each category.

March 2nd (9:00am): Winners in the STUDENT and ADULT categories will be announced!

April 28th, 2020: ELECTION DAY! Vote on election day and collect Philly's brand new Election Day stickers! Don't forget to tag us at #IVotedPHL in any posts!

##### STUDENT-

- K-8th grade
- 9-12th grade
- College/University

##### ADULT:

- Amateur
- Intermediate
- Professional
