I don't think there's been an 22 23 announcement since August 31st. 24 And when you announce the meetings,

Page 5 1 just include a link to the meeting agenda with each announcement so that members of the 2 public have a reasonable opportunity to find 3 4 the agenda and thereby to comment on the business before the Board. So we offer this as one of -- a number 6 of recommendations to bring this Board into compliance with the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act 8 9 for better transparency and to encourage public participation. 10 11 I want to give you each a copy of our 12 recommendations, which we circulated to you 13 before for each of you. As always we're ready to work with the 14 Board to improve public participation in Board 15 16 activities. Thank you. 20	Completed cover pages for online filers	
21	of Cycle 4 campaign finance reports are due on	
22	October 1st.	
23	The Voter Registration unit report for	
24	the election cycle to date they have
