Such notice must be posted for at least ten (10) days, in at least five (5) public and conspicuous places in the district or districts to be affected thereby; and at least one such notice shall be posted on or in the immediate vicinity of the polling place in the district.



PETITION TO REDRAW, REVISE AND MODIFY THE ELECTION DISTRICT BOUNDARIES OF THE $1^{\rm ST}$ AND $7^{\rm TH}$ ELECTION DISTRICTS OF THE $30^{\rm TH}$ WARD AND CREATE THE $18^{\rm TH}$ ELECTION DISTRICT OF THE $30^{\rm TH}$ WARD

Petitioner, the Philadelphia County Board of Elections, by and through its undersigned counsel, in accordance with 25 P.S. § 2704, petitions this Court for an order to redraw, revise, and modify the boundaries of the 1st and 7th Election Districts of the 30th Ward and create the 18th Election District of the 30th Ward as set forth below:

- 1. The 1st and 7th Election Districts of the 30th Ward are located at the northeastern part of the 30th Ward.
- 2. The 1st Election District of the 30th Ward is bounded by Fitzwater Street, 18th Street, South Street, and 15th Street. *See* Exhibit A at 1-2.
- 3. The 7th Election District of the 30th Ward is bounded by Bainbridge Street, 21st Street, Tryon Street, 22nd Street, Lombard Street, and 18th Street. *See* Exhibit A at 3-4.

- 4. During the 2019 Municipal Primary and Special Election, the 1st Election District of the 30th Ward voted at Gideon Hall at Scottish Rite House located at 1525 Fitzwater Street.
- 5. During the 2019 Municipal Primary and Special Election, the 7th Election District of the 30th Ward voted at Penn Medicine at Rittenhouse located at 1800 Lombard Street.
- 6. An influx of recent residential construction in these election districts has created an unusually high number of registered electors.
 - 7. The 1st Election District of the 30th Ward has 1,173 electors.
 - 8. The 7th Election District of the 30th Ward has 1,258 electors.
- 9. This high number of electors creates long waiting times at the polls on Election Day, an unnecessary burden to the electors.
- 10. According to the Pennsylvania Election Code, "[t]he county board of elections may . . . petition the court for the division or redivision of any . . . ward or election district into two or more election districts, or for the alteration of the bounds of any election district, or for the formation of one or more election districts out of two or more existing election districts, or parts thereof." 25 P.S. § 2704.
- 11. The petition must include "a map and a verbal description of the boundaries of the proposed new election districts" and "a certification of the number of electors registered in each of the resulting election districts for the immediately preceding general or municipal election." *Id.*
- 12. "Upon the presentation of any such petition by the county board, the court may make such order for the division, redivision, alteration, formation or consolidation of election districts, as will, in its opinion, promote the convenience of electors and the public interests:

 Provided [sufficient notice is provided]." *Id*.

- 13. Dividing the aforementioned election districts will alleviate unnecessary burdens for these electors.
- 14. The proposed modification for the 1st Election District of the 30th Ward will consist of the following new boundaries: Fitzwater Street, Chadwick Street, Bainbridge Street, 17th Street, South Street, and 15th Street. *See* Exhibits B. C.
- 15. The proposed modification for the 7th Election District of the 30th Ward will consist of the following new boundaries: Bainbridge Street, 21st Street, Tryon Street, 22nd Street, Lombard Street, 20th Street, South Street, and 19th Street. *See* Exhibits B, D.
- 16. The proposed creation of the 18th Election District of the 30th Ward will consist of the following new boundaries: Fitzwater Street, 18th Street, Bainbridge Street, 19th Street, South Street, 20th Street, Lombard Street, 18th Street, South Street, 17th Street, Bainbridge Street, and Chadwick Street. *See* Exhibits B, E.
- 17. The tentative polling place location for the electors of the proposed 1st Election District of the 30th Ward will be Gideon Hall at Scottish Rite House located at 1525 Fitzwater Street.
- 18. The tentative polling place location for the electors of the proposed 7th Election District of the 30th Ward will be the Philadelphia School located at 2501 Lombard Street.
- 19. The tentative polling place location for the electors of the proposed 18th Election District of the 30th Ward will be Penn Medicine at Rittenhouse located at 1800 Lombard Street.

WHEREFORE, the Philadelphia County Board of Elections request the Court to revise, redraw, and modify the Election District boundaries of the 1st and 7th Election Districts of the 30th Ward and create the 18th Election District of the 30th Ward, according to the attached plan.







The new 7th Election District of the 30th Ward will have approximately $677\ {\rm electors.}$


